ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 25, 2019

- 1 ORD 83-2019 authorizing the issuance of a bond of the City in a principal amount not to exceed \$95,000,000 for sale to the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund of the State of Ohio to finance the costs of improvements to the City's wastewater system; pledging certain revenues from the City's wastewater system on a subordinated basis to secure the payment of the principal of and interest on the Bond; and authorizing the execution and delivery of the Bond, the Trust Agreement and other documents and the taking of other actions related to the issuance and sale of the Bond; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 2 ORD 84-2019 accepting a dedication plat for White Pond Parkway; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 3 ORD 85-2019 amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 251-2018, which authorized the sale of City-owned land located at 630 & 642 Diagonal Road in order to promote new housing construction in keeping with Mayor Horrigan's "Planning to Grow Akron" strategy for increasing the City's population and revitalizing its neighborhoods; restating said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 4 ORD 86-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement and/or legislation with the Ohio Director of Transportation for certain improvements on State Routes 18 and 261; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 5 ORD 87-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contract or contracts for the reconstruction of the Akron Fulton Airport Aprons A & B; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 6 ORD 88-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service to submit an application and enter into an agreement with the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority for a Community Recycling Access Grant, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of supporting new and existing community recycling projects and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 7 RES 89-2019 declaring it necessary to improve Market Street between the termini of Westgate Circle and Portage Path, North Main Street between the termini of Olive Street and East Tallmadge Avenue and North High Street between the termini of Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard and East Market Street by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 8 ORD 90-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for HVAC maintenance service at the Water Distribution facilities for a period of three years; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 9 ORD 91-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for the replacement of lead service lines at residences throughout the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 10 RES 92-2019 adopting an annual operating budget for the fiscal year 2019; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Neal abstained)
- 11 ORD 93-2019 to make the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2019; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 12 ORD 94-2019 authorizing the execution of a development agreement with RMMLLB, LLC (the “LLC”) and Kenmore Neighborhood Alliance (“KNA”); providing for the acquisition, sale and redevelopment of property as part of the Great Streets Akron Initiative; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
