PLANNING

- 1 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a garage at 1286 Woodward Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *(Scheduled for Public Hearing – April 8, 2019)*

- 2 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a three-unit development at 655 Oxford Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *(Scheduled for Public Hearing – April 8, 2019)*

- 3 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a used tire store at 1428 Copley Road; and declaring an emergency. *(Scheduled for Public Hearing – April 8, 2019)*

- 4 ORDINANCE approving the sale of 60 Elinor Ave. to Just G LLC; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

- 5 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into an agreement for title, appraisal and review appraisal services and Acquisition/Relocation Consultant services to carry out the Community Development Program, and other programs; and declaring an emergency.

- 6 ORDINANCE approving the sale of City-owned property located at 526 S Main Street, Akron, OH 44311, otherwise known as the Bounce Building at Canal Place; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE

- 7 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contract or contracts for the construction of Citywide Sidewalks 2019; and declaring an emergency.
- 8 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Best Equipment Co. for the purchase of one used rear loading packer truck; and declaring an emergency.
- 9 ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the removal and abatement of the vinyl flooring in certain rooms in the Joy Park Community Center; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- 10 ORDINANCE authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Matrix Pointe Software, LLC for the purchase of user licenses to access and use the Matrix Pointe Software; and declaring an emergency
- 11 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor or his designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts with Involta, LLC for the purchase of dedicated Public Safety Department servers and software at Involta's Akron Data Center; and declaring an emergency.
- 11A RESOLUTION opposing the passage of Ohio House Bill 174, which would further erode restrictions on gun possession in Ohio and permit the carrying of concealed firearms without a permit; and declaring an emergency.

PARKS & RECREATION
