PLANNING

- 1 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a retail use at 601 E. Exchange Street; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing Scheduled for May 13, 2019)*
- 2 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a Tim Hortons restaurant at the northwest corner of the intersection of George Washington Boulevard and East Waterloo Road; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing Scheduled for May 13, 2019)*
- 3 ORDINANCE authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a parking lot on the west side of Corwin Avenue, south of E. Cuyahoga Falls Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *(Public Hearing Scheduled for May 13, 2019)*

PUBLIC SERVICE

- 4 RESOLUTION calling upon the Congress of the United States to introduce and pass legislation to create a National Infrastructure Bank in the tradition of Alexander Hamilton and Franklin Roosevelt; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- 5 ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor to apply for, and if awarded, accept a Violence Against Women Act grant administered by the Office of Criminal Justice Services; authorizing the Director of Law to enter into an agreement with Oriana House, Inc. to implement the grant by continuing to fund two investigators for the domestic violence unit; and declaring an emergency.
