### ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 17, 2019

- 1      ORD 173-2019 approving the donation of certain City-owned land to the State of Ohio to facilitate the completion of the State Route 8 Bridge Project; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 2      ORD 174-2019 authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to file an application and enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio for the Homeless Crisis Response Program; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 3      ORD 175-2019 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, or her designee, without the formality of publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for pavement consulting services including continued pavement inspection, analysis, and related management services with Pavement Management Group (PMG); and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 4      ORD 176-2019 determining to proceed with the improvement of North Main Street between the termini of State Route 59 and Market Street and South Main Street between the termini of Market Street and Mill Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and utility vaults; installing street lighting and planting trees; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 5      ORD 177-2019 approving the addition of the property located at 1554, 1558, 1572, and 1576 South Cleveland Massillon Road, in Copley Township to the Copley-Akron Joint Economic Development District; authorizing the Mayor or his designee to amend the Copley-Akron JEDD agreement to include the property located at 1554, 1558, 1572, and 1576 South Cleveland Massillon Road; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 6      ORD 178-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a child day care business center at 474 Ardella Avenue; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 7      ORD 179-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a monument

sign at 1481 E. Market Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 8 RES 180-2019 calling upon the Congress of the United States to introduce and pass legislation to create a National Infrastructure Bank in the tradition of Alexander Hamilton and Franklin Roosevelt; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 8-3 (*Fusco, Hoch, Kammer*) (*Omobien, Sims abstained*)
- 9 ORD 181-2019 providing for the issuance and sale of bonds of the City in a maximum principal amount of \$12,060,000 for the purpose of refunding bonds issued by the City in 2010 to pay the costs of acquiring, constructing, improving, renovating, repairing, enlarging, adding to, reconstructing, maintaining, equipping, furnishing, acquiring interests in real property in connection with, improving the sites of, and otherwise improving, Community Learning Centers, and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 10 ORD 182-2019 authorizing the Mayor or his designee, to enter into amendments (Supplement No. 3) to agreements between the City of Akron and Akron Energy Systems, LLC relating to the refunding of the \$13,200,000 Certificates of Participation, Series 2010 (Akron District Energy Project) previously issued to finance certain improvements to the City's steam, hot water and chilled water system; authorizing the execution of an amendment (Supplement No. 3) to a financing agreement; authorizing actions necessary and incidental thereto; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 11 RESOLUTION opposing House Bill 242 (H.B. 242), the Ohio General Assembly's latest attempt to unreasonably interfere with local decision-making by prohibiting governments from regulating the local use of plastic products or placing any tax or fee on those products; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 11-1 (*Hoch*) (*Neal abstained*)
