ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 15, 2019

- 1 ORD 211-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, to jointly apply for and, if awarded, accept and expend funding from the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) to resurface portions of Gilchrist Road; to expend local funds therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 2 ORD 212-2019 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with M. Campbell Contracting, LLC for the emergency installation of a liner inside a failing water main on State Route 43; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 3 ORD 213-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish an adult day-care business center at 450 White Pond Drive; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 4 ORD 214-2019 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a commercial storage garage at 326 Power Street; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 5 ORD 215-2019 authorizing the execution of a development agreement with 159 Development LLC, or its designee; providing for the acquisition, sale and redevelopment of property in the Downtown Redevelopment Plan Area; finding such Property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 6 ORD 216-2019 repealing and replacing Ordinance No. 429-2018, creating, establishing, and recognizing departments, offices, bureaus, divisions and positions in the classified service of the City of Akron; requiring that only budgeted funded positions be filled; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 7 ORD 217-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for construction of the WRF Headworks Improvements Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 8 ORD 218-2019 authorizing the Mayor to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (“WPCLF”) bond and to sign all documents for and enter into WPCLF agreements with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”) and the Ohio Water Development Authority (“OWDA”) for the construction of the WRF Headworks Improvements Project; and declaring an emergency.
