### AKRON CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 22, 2019

- 1 ORD 219-2019 levying special assessments and determining to proceed with public improvements and public services for the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District in accordance with Ordinance No. 2-2019 which approved the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District and the Plan for Services to be provided by the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District, Inc., all when and where necessary, all together with the necessary appurtenances thereto; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 2 ORD 220-2019 approving and authorizing the execution of a ground lease-purchase agreement, providing for the lease, sale and redevelopment of approximately 6.1 acres of property in the Massillon Road Industrial Park Urban Redevelopment Area to Stark State College to establish a commercial driver's license training program, pursuant to the Massillon Road Industrial Park Urban Redevelopment Plan, for the purpose of encouraging urban redevelopment according to the Plan; finding such property is not needed by the City for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 3 ORD 221-2019 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into an agreement with the Summit County Land Reutilization Corporation ("SCLB") in order to proceed with the acquisition and redevelopment of blighted real property known as 220 East Mill Street within the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 4 ORD 222-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for improvements to State Routes 76 and 77; declaring that said project is in the public interest; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 5 ORD 223-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for improvements to State Route 8; declaring that said project is in the public interest; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0

- 6 ORD 224-2019 authorizing the Director of Public Service, or his designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into a contract or contracts for construction of the Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction 2018 Small Diameter Lining Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 7 ORD 225-2019 authorizing the Mayor to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (“WPCLF”) bond and to sign all documents for and enter into WPCLF agreements with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”) and the Ohio Water Development Authority (“OWDA”) for the construction of the Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction 2018 Small Diameter Lining Project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 8 ORD 226-2019 authorizing the Mayor to apply for a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (“WPCLF”) bond and to sign all documents for and enter into WPCLF agreements with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”) and the Ohio Water Development Authority (“OWDA”) for the construction of the Duane Green Project in East Akron to control sewer overflows; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 9 ORD 227-2019 appropriating funds for the resurfacing of certain state routs and minor bridge work to be completed by the Ohio Department of Transportation; authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement or agreements with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the resurfacing of certain streets and for certain bridge improvements; requesting the Ohio Director of Transportation to proceed with the project; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 10 ORD 228-2019 determining to proceed with and levying special assessments for the improvement and maintenance of the off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 13-0
- 11 ORD 229-2019 authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to apply for and, if awarded, accept and expend a grant administered by Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP), part of the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs; and declaring an emergency. VOTE 12-0 (Sims abstained)
- 12 RES 230-2019 opposing and objecting to the renewal application of Northside Tavern, LLC, 956 N Howard Street, Akron, Ohio 44310 for a Class D2, D2X, D3 and D6 liquor permits (6451230) now pending before the Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency.VOTE 13-0
