AKRON CITY COUNCIL ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 9, 2019

RES 252-2019 expressing support of the American Association of Retired Person (“AARP”) Network of Age-Friendly Cities and Communities; expressing support of the City’s application for membership to the Network of Age-Friendly Cities and Communities; and declaring an emergency. VOTE: 13-0

ORD 253-2019 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, or her designee, after publicly advertising for bids, to enter into contracts to provide for the remounting and refurbishment of one 2007 Taylor-Made emergency medical unit; and declaring an emergency. VOTE: 13-0

ORD 254-2019 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for, and if awarded, accept and expend grant funding from the Ohio Attorney General’s Office Law Enforcement Diversion Program to support the local collaborative Quick Response Team to address opioid overdoses; and declaring an emergency. VOTE: 13-0

ORD 255-2019 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for, and if awarded, accept and expend grant funding from the 2019 Justice Assistance Grant administered through the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance designed to provide law enforcement agencies with the flexibility to prioritize and utilize justice funds where they are needed most; and declaring an emergency. VOTE: 13-0

ORD 256-2019 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for, and if awarded, accept and expend grant funding from the Akron Community Foundation Millennium Fund for Children; and declaring an emergency. VOTE: 13-0

ORD 257-2019 authorizing the Mayor or his designee to apply for, and if awarded, accept and expend grant funding from the Ben Roethlisberger Foundation to expand and improve the K-9 unit of the City’s Police Department; and declaring an emergency. VOTE:13-0

RES 258-2019 expressing support of the Summit County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board's plan to place a levy on the November 5, 2019 ballot and authorizing Summit County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board ("ADM Board") to use the name of the Council for the City of Akron for advertisements and general publicity purposes related to the levy campaign; and declaring an emergency. VOTE: 12-0 (Omobien abstained)
