

NEW LEGISLATION – JULY 6, 2009

PLANNING:

1. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to file an application with the State of Ohio for the Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program; to enter into all necessary contracts for the operation and term of the Program; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC SERVICE:

2. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction of improvements to South Main Street from Boxwood Avenue to Dartmore Avenue and 517' north of Wilbeth Road to Firestone Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

PUBLIC UTILITIES:

3. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of labor and materials to rebuild the Primary Tank skimmer system at the Water Pollution Control Station; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

4. Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract for the purchase of a replacement sewer television camera and assembly parts for use by the Sewer Maintenance Division; and declaring an emergency.

5. Ordinance ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Workman Industrial Services for the emergency repair of a 60-inch sluice gate in the High Lift Pump Station at the Water Supply Plant; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & JOB CREATION:

6. Ordinance approving the sale of City owned land to Juan E. Jackson; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

7. Ordinance accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the NEIGHBORHOOD INITIATIVE PROGRAM project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.
