

NEW LEGISLATION LIST – FEBRUARY 8, 2010

BUDGET AND FINANCE:

0. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into a loan guaranty agreement with the International Soap Box Derby, Inc., and FirstMerit Bank; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

PLANNING:

1. Ordinance approving, with modification, the renewal application of Frank S. and Mary Politz to have agricultural property at 1661 Dreisbach Drive placed in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, *et seq.*; and declaring an emergency.

2. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into an agreement with the Urban Neighborhood Development Corporation (UNDC) to provide for the construction and sale of moderate cost single-family homes on a non-profit basis within the Community Development Activity Area; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

2A. Resolution adopting the 2010 Capital Investment and Community Development Program, also known as the Capital Investment Budget; and declaring an emergency. **(Substitute offered as an Amendment)**

PUBLIC SERVICE:

3. Ordinance authorizing the Mayor to file a grant application and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources to receive funding for certain capital improvements through the State of Ohio’s Clean Ohio Trail Fund to construct the Northside Train Station Connector; and declaring an emergency.

4. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to submit an application and enter into an agreement with the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority for a Community Recycling Access Grant; and declaring an emergency.

4A. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of a large format multifunction graphics printer for use in the design office of Utilities Engineering; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

PARKS AND RECREATION:

5. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the Akron Amateur Basketball Officials Association for the provision of officials for the city-wide youth basketball program during the 2010 season; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES:

6. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Health to enter into a contract with Violet’s Cupboard, Inc. for primary care services for persons living with HIV/AIDS in underserved communities; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.
