

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 5, 2007

ORD. NO. 91-2007 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM 261 – 11.57 / TALLMADGE AVENUE project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 92-2007 authorizing the donation of a used City-owned truck to the County of Summit; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 93-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with a consultant for the design and construction management of renovations to the Superblock Parking Deck; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 94-2007 authorizing the Mayor to appoint substitute or special patrol officers to supplement the Akron Police Division; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 95-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Ziad F. Elia and Holley E. Elia, located at 263 Silver Street, for the purposes of eliminating conditions of blight and preventing the recurrence thereof, facilitating the development of new housing and furthering the objectives of the Hickory Corridor/Cascade Locks Urban Renewal Plan; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 96-2007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Craun-Leibing Company, without the formality of advertising for bids, to purchase a Gorman-Rupp Autostart Pump Station (Emergency Retrofit) for the Fairhill Drive Pump Station; and declaring and emergency.

ORD. NO. 97-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with a consultant for the design of the reconstruction of South Main Street between Firestone Blvd. and Waterloo Road; authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with ODOT for the design and reconstruction of South Main Street between Firestone Blvd. and Waterloo Road; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 98-2007 declaring it necessary to improve Hartford Avenue between the termini of Copley Road and Lawton Street and Nome Avenue between the termini of Courtland Avenue and Tacker Road by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, driveway approaches, concrete sidewalks and brick pavement; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 99-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and/or lease of various equipment used in daily operations of various City departments; approving specifications

therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 100-2007 expressing support for Carter Lumber Company and its trade show program; and declaring an emergency.
