

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 2, 2007

ORD. NO. 139-2007 authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of various policies of airport liability insurance; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 140-2007 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the HICKORY STREET IMPROVEMENTS project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 141-2007 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM 261 – 11.57 / TALLMADGE AVENUE project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 142-2007 approving and confirming the appointments of Donald Plusquellic, Richard Merolla, Warren Woolford, Gerald Egan, Councilwoman Renee Greene, Councilman Bruce Kilby, and Councilman Michael Williams for the year 2007 as members of the Northeast Ohio Four County Regional Planning and Development Organization; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 143-2007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Buckeye Power Sales, without the formality of advertising for bids, for inspection, maintenance, and repair of emergency power generators at various City of Akron locations; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 144-2007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with The K Company, Inc. for the labor and material to replace the dehumidifier in the Citi-Center pool area; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 145-2007 amending The Zoning Map by changing the Apartment House Use District (U2, H1, A2) Classification from Abbot Court, south to Crouse Street between Spicer Street and Kirn Street to a Retail Business Use District (U3, H1, A1) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 146-2007 accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Ames Court, south of Hazel Street, from North Adams Street, east for approximately 175 feet; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 147-2007 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into a contract or contracts with non-profit neighborhood based organizations for the provision of services in order to carry out the intent and purpose of the Neighborhood Partnership program; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 148-2007 accepting the eligibility report for the Edgewood Urban Renewal Area and approving the Edgewood Urban Renewal Area Renewal Plan; making necessary findings in connection therewith; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 149-2007 amending The Zoning Map by changing the Apartment House Use District (U2, H1, A3) Classification along the north side of Vernon Odom Boulevard between Edgewood Avenue and Raymond Street to a Retail Business Use District (U3, H1, A2) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 150-2007 providing for the issuance and sale of a note in the principal amount of \$21,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds to pay the property owners' portion, in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments, of the cost of improving Laird Street between certain termini by paving, grading, constructing and reconstructing curbs, sidewalks and driveway approaches, installing roof drain pipes, and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 151-2007 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in certain real property owned by Mae Bennett, Archie Berry, Albert Berry (aka Alfred Berry), Ruth Berry and James Berry, Jr., located at 217 Hickory Street, for the purposes of making or repairing roads that are open to the public; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 152-2007 determining to proceed with the improvement of Howard Street between Lods Street and Cuyahoga Falls Avenue by paving, grading, constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, sanitary sewer house laterals, sanitary sewers, storm sewers and water mains, installing roof drain pipes, installing street lighting, installing traffic signalization and planting trees; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 153-2007 determining to proceed with the improvement of Hampton Knoll Drive between the termini of Akron-Peninsula Road and the cul-de-sac by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, driveway approaches and storm sewers; and planting trees; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 154-2007 levying special assessments for the improvement of Youtz Avenue between certain termini by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, sidewalks, and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes; constructing storm sewers; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 155-2007 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2007 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 156-2007 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2007 Phase I Micro Paving Program) by resurfacing such streets by the method known as “micro-paving”; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 157-2007 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2007 Phase I Partial Depth Pavement Replacement Program) by repaving such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 158-2007 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2007 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 159-2007 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2007 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 160-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2007 Arterial Collector Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 161-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the removal and installation of asphalt pavement and full depth pavement reclamation for the 2007 Partial Depth Pavement Replacement Program; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 162-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2007 Residential Resurfacing Program; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 163-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal and riser rings for various streets in the 2007 Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 164-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic rejuvenating agent for various streets in 2007 for the Construction Seal Program; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 165-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Services to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the resurfacing of I-76 from I-277 to I-77

and I-277/US 224 from the Manchester Road Bridge to the Arlington Street Bridge; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.
