

## **ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 30, 2007**

ORD. NO. 220-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for construction of a Building on the Summit Lake Community Center grounds for equipment storage and maintenance; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 221-2007 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and accept funding from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Office of Grants and Training, for the FY 2006 Commercial Equipment Direct Assistance Program; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 222-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to place rooftop antennas at 520 South Main Street (Canal Place); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 223-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of the Innes Community Learning Center at 1999 East Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 224-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of the Barber Community Learning Center at 665 Garry Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 225-2007 declaring certain improvements to real property located in the South Main-Miller Redevelopment Area to be a public purpose and exempt from real property taxation, providing for the collection of service payments in lieu of taxes, providing for the payment of a portion of said service payments to the Akron Public School District, establishing the South Main-Miller Redevelopment Area Redevelopment Tax Increment Equivalent Fund (JBM), all pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.41 to 5709.43 (the "Act"); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 226-2007 amending and/or supplementing Title 15, Chapter 153 "Zoning Code" Section 153.534 "Class UPD-13 District" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron, by permitting fee-simple ownership of land under condominium units in the district and by improving access to the properties in the district; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 227-2007 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by Eugene Evans, located at 564 Allyn Street, for the purposes of constructing the Leggett Community Learning Center, a building that will be used by the City of Akron and the Akron Public Schools; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 228-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest, a temporary right-of-way easement, a utility easement and work agreement easement interest in certain real property owned by William R. Hunt III and Brenda Hunt, located at 601 and 613 E. Tallmadge Ave., for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are

open to the public in conjunction with the SUM 261-11.57/Tallmadge Avenue Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 229-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Paul E. Spencer and Roberta A. Spencer, located at 319 Cross Street, for the purpose of constructing the Leggett Community Learning Center, a building that will be used by the City of Akron and the Akron Public Schools; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 230-2007 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Bonita Byrd and William E. Byrd, located at 345 Cross Street, for the purpose of constructing the Leggett Community Learning Center, a building that will be used by the City of Akron and the Akron Public Schools; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 231-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for construction of the Dart Avenue Parking Deck; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 232-2007 determining to proceed with the improvement of Pelton Avenue between the termini of Celtic Street and Allenford Street, Celtic Street between the termini of Manchester Road and Edwin Avenue, and Westmoreland Street between the termini of Manchester Road and Nesmith Lake Boulevard by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers and water mains; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 234-2007 authorizing the Mayor to accept a thermal imager camera and accessories from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Office of Grants and Training, for use by the Fire Division; and declaring an emergency.
