

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 21, 2007

ORD. NO. 259-2007 accepting various right of way document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM 261-11.57 / TALLMADGE AVENUE Project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 260-2007 authorizing the Mayor to file an application with assurances and certifications with the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Supportive Housing Program for Stewart B. McKinney funds for the homeless; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 261-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the relocation of the traffic signal on South Broadway near the Summit County Courthouse; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 262-2007 authorizing the Director of Health to enter into a personal services contract with Panethong Rassavong Lynum to provide a Refugee Health Outreach Service for refugees resettled in Akron; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 263-2007 amending and/or supplementing Ord. No. 558-1977, which authorized a Conditional Use to permit the establishment of off-street parking, landscaping and other accessory facilities for a vehicle parts salvaging and sales operation on property at 66 West Waterloo Road by changing the name of the Petitioner; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 264-2007 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Greater Akron Chamber for economic development activities and business services to be performed in 2007; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 265-2007 expressing support for the application of The Community Builders, Inc., in partnership with the Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority as HOPE VI grantee, to the Ohio Housing Finance Agency for Low Income Housing Tax Credits for the Cascade Village East-West Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 266-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish parking at 646-650 Elma Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 267-2007 Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with the Milton Township Volunteer Fire Department for the sale of a pumper truck which is no longer needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 268-2007 approving and authorizing the execution of a Contract for Sale for Private Redevelopment (“Redevelopment Contract”) with METRO Regional Transit Authority (“Redeveloper”); providing for the sale and redevelopment of property pursuant to the terms of that Contract; finding such property not needed for public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 269-2007 honoring Richard L. Aynes as he concludes his 12-year tenure as Dean of The University of Akron School of Law; and declaring an emergency.
