

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 9, 2007

ORD. NO. 351-2007 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the WEST MARKET STREET project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 352-2007 changing the name of Coddling Street to Wabash Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 353-2007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract for the purchase and installation of a protective netting system at the Pickle Road ball fields; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 354-2007 amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 106-1996, passed on February 26, 1996, which authorized a Conditional Use to permit the establishment of a coffee house and hypnotherapy office on property at 277 East Mill Street by changing the name of the owner and the permitted use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 355-2007 providing for the issuance and sale of bonds in a maximum principal amount of \$920,000 to pay the property owners' portion, in anticipation of the collection of special assessments previously levied, of the cost of improving certain streets between certain termini by making various street, sidewalk, storm and sanitary sewer, and water system improvements; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 356-2007 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay the AMATS Trust Fund for costs associated with the City's participation in the AMATS program; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 357-2007 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay the membership dues for fiscal year 2008 to the Northeast Ohio Four County Regional Planning and Development Organization (NEFCO) in the amount of \$43,415.00; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 358-2007 levying special assessments and determining to proceed with the improvement of various off-street parking facilities known as the Kenmore Business District et al. including the Canton Road parking facility by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and all when and where necessary, and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 359-2007 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract to provide comprehensive residential alcohol-drug treatment at Interval Brotherhood Home; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 360-2007 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and accept one TecSight SE35 Advanced Thermal Imager Kit from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Office of Grants and Training, FY 2007 Commercial Equipment Direct Assistance Program; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 361-2007 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and accept funding from the State of Ohio, Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation, for the purchase of a Live Scan Digital Finger Print System; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 362-2007 authorizing the purchase of land on the northwest corner of Rhodes Avenue and Vernon Odom Boulevard from the State of Ohio; authorizing payment therefore and declaring an emergency.

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
