

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 15, 2007

ORD. NO. 523-2007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to obtain proposals and enter into a contract for the sale of used oil and antifreeze; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 524-2007 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract or contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of miscellaneous materials and services needed by the Department of Public Safety and Municipal Court for a period of time not to exceed 3 years; approving the specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 525-2007 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with Law Enforcement Associates, Pro Tech Security Sales, and Kell Systems for the purchase of miscellaneous equipment to be used by the Akron Police Division per specifications; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 526-2007 accepting a sewer easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the WHITE POND PHASE 1 Project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 527-2007 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the WEST MARKET STREET Project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 528-2007 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron for the WEST MARKET STREET Project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 529-2007 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron for the EDGEWOOD REDEVELOPMENT AREA Project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 530-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a self-storage complex at 1016 Morse Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 531-2007 providing for the issuance and sale of \$390,000 bonds for the purpose of paying costs of renovating, equipping and otherwise improving certain facilities of the City Fire Department, all together with the necessary appurtenances thereto; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 532-2007 providing for the issuance and sale of \$545,000 bonds for the purpose of paying costs of renovating, equipping and otherwise improving the Municipal Service Center, all together with the necessary appurtenances thereto; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 533-2007 providing for the issuance and sale of \$985,000 bonds for the purpose of providing funds to pay a portion of the settlement of claims approved by the court as final judgment rendered against the City in an action for compensation in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, being Case No. 5:02 CV 2047, entitled Elizabeth Kish v. City of Akron, et al., and certain interest and financing costs; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 534-2007 providing for the issuance and sale of \$1,755,000 bonds for the purpose of paying costs of improving the Municipal Complex including CitiCenter, the Municipal Building, the Harold K. Stubbs Justice Center and other municipal buildings and facilities by constructing, reconstructing, renovating, repairing roofs, remodeling, improving air conditioning systems, making site and other improvements, planning and designing facilities and acquiring and installing related equipment, all as applicable, designated or to be designated by the Director of Public Services, all together with the necessary equipment and appurtenances thereto; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 535-2007 providing for the issuance and sale of \$2,650,000 bonds for the purpose of paying costs of acquiring and equipping motor vehicles for various Divisions of the City, including trucks, police vehicles and an ambulance, together with other equipment and all appurtenances thereto; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 536-2007 providing for the issuance and sale of \$2,920,000 bonds for the purpose of paying costs of improving the municipal parks and recreational system by acquiring, constructing, improving and equipping parks and recreational facilities including Davenport Park, Beech Street Trailhead, Towpath Trails (AES-Bartges, Kenmore, Summit Lake, Waterloo), Lock 3 Redevelopment, Cascade Locks Bikeway, playing courts and fields, community centers and other park and recreational facilities, designated or to be designated by the Director of Public Service, and making site improvements and acquiring real property and interests therein in connection therewith, together with all necessary facilities and appurtenances thereto; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 537-2007 providing for the issuance and sale of \$11,700,000 for the purpose of paying costs of improving Avon Street, Bartges Street, Canton Road, East Market Street, Elm Avenue, Hampton Knoll Drive, Howard Street, Ridge Street, High Street, Massillon Road, Mill Street, Pelton Avenue, Perkins Street, West Market Street and certain other streets and properties in the City, and related bridges and viaducts, and such street improvements for the Hickory development area, the Highland Square development area, the Edgewood Homes Hope development project, the West Side Office Park project and the Five Points Renewal Area, all in accordance with plans prepared by the City Engineer, by constructing, reconstructing, widening, paving, grading, draining, resurfacing, constructing curbs, sidewalks, driveway approaches and off-street parking lots, reconstructing for ADA accessibility, installing roof drain pipes, water service connections and sanitary sewer laterals, constructing water lines, sanitary sewers, storm sewers and storm outlets, restoring channels for storm water flow, installing signalization, installing retaining walls and otherwise improving the same, all

where necessary and as applicable and together with all necessary appurtenances thereto; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 538-2007 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement for funding of airport improvements through the State of Ohio's FY2008 Ohio Airport Improvement Grant Program; committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 539-2007 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Otis Elevator Company for the Purchase of labor and materials for service and maintenance on the elevators at the Akron Global Business Accelerator; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 540-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the reconstruction of existing sanitary sewers in various locations throughout the City; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 541-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the resurfacing and improvement of Manchester Road, Copley Road, Maple Street, and Glendale Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 542-2007 authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service, the Director of Health, and/or the Director of Finance to enter into contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of materials and services needed by the various City departments for a period of time not to exceed 3 years; approving the specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 543-2007 authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service, the Director of Health, and/or the Director of Finance to purchase miscellaneous supplies and repair parts and labor for machinery and equipment used by various divisions of the departments of the City for a period of one (1) year; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 544-2007 amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 62-2007, passed on February 12, 2007, which authorized a Conditional Use to establish Permatex, Inc., on property at 1559 South Main Street by changing the name of the Petitioner and Condition (5) regarding the hours of operation; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 545-2007 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a loan agreement with Saalfeld Square Properties, Inc. to provide funds for the purpose of job creation and retention and to promote private investment and economic development; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 546-2007 urging Akron voters to support Issue 20, the Alcohol Drug Abuse and Mental Health Services Board levy on the November 6, 2007 ballot; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 547-2007 urging Akron voters to support Issue 21 on the November 6, 2007 ballot, the proposed replacement and reduction of an existing tax levy for the Summit County Children Services Board, which is urgently needed to provide compassionate care and protect the County's children from abuse and neglect; and declaring an emergency.
