

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED DECEMBER 10, 2007

ORD. NO. 623-2007 authorizing the expenditure of funds to purchase hospitality items for various Recreation Bureau activities; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 624-2007 authorizing a Conditional Use to vary the side yard area for the construction of a stairway enclosure at 1131 Pitkin Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 625-2007 designating a voting ward for 11.24 acres of land on the south side of Smith Road and addressed as 2102 and 2108 Smith Road, for 2.66 acres of land on the north side of Smith Road and addressed as 1873 Smith Road, for 7.9 acres of land at the southwest corner of the intersection of Smith Road and Riverview Road and addressed as 2152 Riverview Road, and for 2.03 acres of land located at the north end of Foxglove Circle and known as Lot 47 in the Woodbrook Place Allotment, all recently incorporated into the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 626-2007 amending The Zoning Map as referred to in Section 153.220 of the City of Akron Code of Ordinances by establishing a Unified Planned Development District (UPD-23) Classification on 11.24 acres of recently incorporated land on the south side of Smith Road and addressed as 2102 and 2108 Smith Road, and on 2.66 acres of recently incorporated land on the north side of Smith Road and addressed as 1873 Smith Road; by establishing a Limited Business Use District (ULB,H1,A1) Classification on 7.9 acres of recently incorporated land at the southwest corner of the intersection of Smith Road and Riverview Road and addressed as 2152 Riverview Road; by establishing a Single Family Residence Use District (U1,H1,A1) Classification on 2.03 acres of recently incorporated land located at the north end of Foxglove Circle and known as Lot 47 in the Woodbrook Place Allotment; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 627-2007 amending Ordinance No. 128-2007, passed March 26, 2007, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2007, and Ordinance No. 548-2007, passed October 22, 2007, and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 628-2007 providing for the temporary appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the period of January 1, 2008 through March 31, 2008; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 629-2007 amending Ord. No. 590-2007, passed November 19, 2007 to authorize the Director Finance, on behalf of the City, to donate \$20,000 to the "Goods for Guns" gun buy-back program held December 7th and 8th, 2007; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 630-2007 declaring it necessary to improve Kenilworth Drive between the termini of Greenvale Avenue and Garman Road by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches; and storm sewers; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 631-2007 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of improvements to the lobby in the Harold K. Stubbs Justice Center; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 632-2007 approving and authorizing execution of a Development Agreement among the City, County of Summit and IRG Rubber City, LLC and approving and authorizing a Development and Retention Agreement among the City, County of Summit and The Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 633-2007 declaring improvements to certain parcels of real property to be a public purpose, describing the public improvements to be made to directly benefit those parcels, requiring the owner of the improvements thereon to make service payments in lieu of taxes, establishing a municipal public improvement tax increment equivalent fund for the deposit of such service payments, and related authorizations pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 5709.40, 5709.42 and 5709.43; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 634-2007 expressing support for the Ohioans for Healthy Families campaign to submit legislation to the Ohio General Assembly to require businesses with more than 25 workers to allow full-time employees to earn 7 paid sick days per year and part-time workers to earn a pro-rated number of paid sick days; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 635-2007 calling for the immediate and unconditional release of three Israeli soldiers held captive by Hamas and Hezbollah; condemning the militant groups for cross border attacks that led to the kidnappings last year; urging Hamas and Hezbollah to allow prompt medical treatment of the soldiers by representatives of the International Red Cross; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 636-2007 expressing support for the findings of the Predatory Lending Task Force Committee; and declaring an emergency.
