

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 4, 2008

RES. NO. 34-2008 appointing James Shealey to fill the vacancy in the Akron City Council Member-At-Large position for the term ending December 31, 2009; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 35-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the County of Summit for the purchase of oblique imagery data and software to enhance the GIS system in the Engineering Bureau; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 36-2008 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Sutter Electric for emergency repairs to the electrical service at Building #5 at the Municipal Service Center; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 37-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the Greater Akron Amateur Basketball Officials Association for the provision of officials for the city-wide youth basketball program during the 2007-2008 season; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 38-2008 amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 146-2005, passed on March 21, 2005, which authorized a Conditional Use to permit the establishment of a drive-thru on property at 522 Vernon Odom Boulevard by revising the site plan, changing Condition (1) to require fencing along the west and south property lines, adding Condition (9) regarding removal of storage trailers; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 39-2008 amending The Zoning Map by changing a portion of the Unified Planned Development District (UPD-12) Classification south of Morse Street and east of Romig Road to a Single-Family Residence Use District (U1,H1,A1) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 40-2008 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the SCHUMACHER COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 41-2008 authorizing the Director of Finance, on behalf of the City, to donate \$5,000 to support the Project Homeless Connect Day in Akron on April 29, 2008; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 42-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute, on behalf of the city, an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of 23.62 acres of City owned land and street right of way along North and South Jenkins Boulevard and Virginia Avenue to Ohio Valley Energy Systems Corporation for the "St. Paul's Unit No. 1" gas/oil well unitization; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 43-2008 providing for the issuance and sale of a note in the principal amount of \$597,700, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds to pay the property owners' portion, in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments, of the cost of improving Howard Street between the termini of Lods Street and Cuyahoga Falls Avenue by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, sanitary sewer house laterals, sanitary sewers, storm sewers and water mains; installing roof drain pipes; installing street lighting; installing traffic signalization; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 44-2008 providing for the issuance and sale of \$639,785 of bonds, to pay, in anticipation of the collection of special assessments heretofore levied, the property owners' portion of the cost of improving certain streets in the City; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 45-2008 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SOUTH MAIN STREET – PHASE IV project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 46-2008 declaring the necessity and intent of the City to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by Alvin G. Schindler aka Alvin G. Schindler, Sr., and located off of Waterloo Road along the canal, for park purposes as follows: constructing a public walking and biking trail, and appurtenant parking, specifically a towpath and trailhead; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 47-2008 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest and two temporary easement interests in certain real property owned by Davood Haghighi located at 2168 S. Main Street, for the purposes of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM-SO Main Street Phase IV Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 48-2008 declaring it necessary to improve Dresden Avenue between the termini of South Firestone Boulevard and Brown Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, and storm sewers; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 49-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction and system integration of a freeway management system on IR76/IR77/IR277/SR8; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 50-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the design and construction of improvements to the West Market Street Bridge over SR59; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 51-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the design and construction of improvements to the

south leg of IR77 from the southern corporation limits to the central interchange; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 52-2008 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Kenmore Construction Co. for emergency repairs to the retaining wall supporting Sherwood Drive; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 53-2008 Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with GBS, without the formality of advertising for bids, for the purchase of Adult Probation Program Case Management System Software; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 54-2008 directing the appropriation of a permanent right-of-way interest in certain real property owned by Steven M. and Mary F. Stakleff, located at 404 White Pond Drive, for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the White Pond Phase I Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 55-2008 directing the appropriation of a permanent right-of-way interest in certain real property owned by Frank S. Vaccaro, located at 455 White Pond Drive, for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the White Pond Phase I Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 56-2008 expressing support for Issue 8, the one-quarter-of-one-percent sales tax increase proposed by METRO RTA appearing on the March 4, 2008 ballot; and declaring an emergency.
