

## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 10, 2008

**ORD. NO. 111-2008** accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the N. HAWKINS AVENUE PAVEMENT REPAIR project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 112-2008** authorizing the Mayor to submit a grant application and enter into a grant agreement with the Ohio Historic Preservation Office and the United States Department of the Interior, National Park Service for funding under the Ohio Certified Local Government Grant Program for the identification of historic resources in West Hill; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 113-2008** authorizing the Director of Health to enter into a contract with Keep Akron Beautiful, Inc. for the provision of private property trash and litter removal services; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 114-2008** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of a dump truck for Keep Akron Beautiful; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 115-2008** authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Summit County to designate the City of Akron to serve as System Manager for all activities associated with the 800 MHZ Rebanding Project; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 116-2008** declaring it necessary to improve East Market Street between the termini of South Main Street and Summit Street by constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, and driveway approaches; installing street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 117-2008** declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2008 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 118-2008** declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2008 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 119-2008** declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2008 Phase I Partial Depth Pavement Replacement Program) by repaving such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 120-2008** declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2008 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 121-2008** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Promats, Inc. for the materials and labor to recover and rebuild the field wall padding at Canal Park Stadium; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 122-2008** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2008 Arterial Collector Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.
