

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED APRIL 21, 2008

ORD. NO. 193-2008 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the N. HAWKINS AVENUE PAVEMENT REPAIR project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 194-2008 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Davis Family Roofing for emergency repairs to the Young's Restaurant building on Manchester Road; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 195-2008 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Carmen Construction Company, Inc. for installation of an ADA accessible security door in the O'Neil's Building; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 196-2008 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with the Grunau Company for inspection and testing of the fire sprinkler system at the Cascade Parking Deck; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 197-2008 approving the sale of city-owned land located on the southwest corner of West Market Street and South Valley Street to Rubber City Arches, LLC; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 198-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute, on behalf of the City, an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of 16 acres of City-owned land and street right-of-way along Massillon Road, north of Triplett Boulevard to Ohio Valley Energy System Corporation for the "BNS Unit No. 1" gas/oil well unitization; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 199-2008 amending and/or supplementing the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron to centralize and enhance enforcement of nuisance violations; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 200-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of a senior housing complex on the south side of Clifford Avenue, west of Inman Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 201-2008 directing the appropriation of a fee simple interest in real property owned by Alvin G. Schindler aka Alvin G. Schindler, Sr., located off of Waterloo Road along the canal, for park purposes as follows: constructing a public walking and biking trail, and appurtenant parking, specifically a towpath and trailhead for the SUM – Waterloo Road Towpath Trail; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 202-2008 Ordinance determining to proceed with the improvement of North Hawkins Avenue between the termini of West Market Street and Thurmont Road by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, and driveway approaches;

installing roof drain pipes; repairing concrete pavement; and planting trees; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 203-2008 determining to proceed with the improvement of certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 204-2008 determining to proceed with the improvement of East Market Street between the termini of south Main Street and Summit Street by constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, and driveway approaches; installing street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 205-2008 authorizing the Director of public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the installation of precision approach path indicator lights on the main runway at the Akron Fulton Airport; approving specifications therefore: and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 206-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of protective sleeves for self contained breathing apparatus air cylinders for firefighter/medics; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 207-2008 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estate in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for LAND BANKING purposes; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 208-2008 urging that careful consideration be given to requests to place pay phones on any public way in the City; and declaring an emergency.
