

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 23, 2008

ORD. NO. 301-2008 accepting a vacation plat for Blinn Street located south of Evans Avenue, east of Dan Street, north of Hollibaugh Avenue, and west of Damon Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 302-2008 approving the transfer of two City-owned vacant parcels of land in Geauga County located on the west side of Claridon Troy Road (State Route 700) north of US Route 422 to Mary D. and Richard S. Lambert in exchange for riverfront property located on the east side of the Cuyahoga River owned by said Mary D. and Richard S. Lambert for greater protection of Akron's water supply; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 303-2008 authorizing the Mayor to file applications and to enter into agreements for funding of certain capital improvements under the Ohio Public Works Commission's Local Transportation Improvement Program (LTIP) and the State Capital Improvements Program (SCIP); committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 304-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of labor and materials to refurbish Fire and EMS vehicles; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 305-2008 declaring it necessary to improve Manchester Road between the termini of West Thornton Street and East Avenue, Copley Road between the termini of Mercer Avenue and Edgewood Avenue, South Maple Street between the termini of Edgewood Avenue and Glendale Avenue and Glendale Avenue between the termini of South Maple Street and Rand Street by resurfacing; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 306-2008 determining to proceed with the improvement of Rexford Street between the termini of Manchester Road and Conrad Avenue and Pelton Avenue between the termini of Rexford Street and Celtic Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers and water main; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 307-2008 determining to proceed with the improvement of Hickory Street between the termini of 40 feet northwest of Howard Court and West North Street and North Maple Street between the termini of Hickory Street and 300 feet north of Hickory Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, water service connections, sanitary sewer house laterals, storm sewers, sanitary sewers, water mains and storm sewer laterals; installing roof drain pipes and street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 308-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Akron Art Museum for outdoor concerts in 2008; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 309-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Akron Symphony Orchestra to provide outdoor concerts at various locations throughout the City during 2008; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 310-2008 authorizing the Director of Health to enter into a personal services contract with Panethong Rassavong Lynum to provide a Refugee Health Outreach Service for refugees resettled in Akron; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 311-2008 urging the Ohio Department of Transportation to close the Wolf Ledges entrance ramp on northbound I-77; and declaring an emergency.
