

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 7, 2008

ORD. NO. 316-2008 accepting a utility easement for property described below in the City of Akron, for the BROWN STREET, ET AL Project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 317-2008 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the EDGEWOOD REDEVELOPMENT AREA project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 318-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Downtown Hotel Company, Ltd. to provide amendments to agreements for loan and bond repayment; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 319-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a carport within the side yard area at 1931 Adelaide Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 320-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a monopole insert telecommunications tower on the west side of North Revere Road, north of Smith Road and south of Paddock Drive; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 321-2008 (5) Ordinance amending The Zoning Map by changing a portion of the Unified Planned Development District (UPD-6) Classification on property located on the south side of Springfield Lake Boulevard between Louis Avenue and Hilbish Avenue to a Single Family Residence Use District (U1,H1,A1) Classification; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 322-2008 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of a multi-unit residential development south of Morse Street and east of Newdale Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 323-2008 Ordinance approving and authorizing the execution of a contract for private redevelopment with InfoCision Management Corporation (“Redeveloper”) providing for the redevelopment of property in the Bath-Akron-Fairlawn Joint Economic Development District, and related findings; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 324-2008 levying special assessments and determining to proceed with the improvement of various off-street parking facilities known as the Kenmore Business District et al. including the Canton Road parking facility by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and all when and where necessary; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 325-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Beech Street Trailhead; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 326-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Waterloo Road Towpath Trail; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 327-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the resurfacing of I-76 from the Kenmore leg to the Central Interchange; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 328-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and/or lease of various equipment used in daily operations of the Public Utilities Bureau; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 329-2008 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the Catholic Youth Organization for operation of the Summer Recreation Program for Disabled Youth; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 330-2008 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest and a temporary right of way interest in certain real property owned by Carl Mueller, located at 220 East Mill Street, for the purposes of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge and for making and repairing bridges and approaches thereto in connection with the Mill Street Bridge Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 331-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with J. W. Hornyak Videoconferencing for videoconferencing equipment, installation and training at the Akron Global Business Accelerator; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.
