

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 17, 2008

ORD. NO. 501-2008 authorizing AkroChem Corporation to construct a storm sewer on Huntington Avenue to eliminate a ponding and icing problem; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 502-2008 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Kenmore Construction Company for the emergency repair of the concrete pavement on the Innerbelt; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 503-2008 approving the donation of City owned land to Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 504-2008 approving the sale of City owned land to Lakewood Partners, LLC; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 505-2008 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM 93 – 8.50 / MANCHESTER ROAD project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 506-2008 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the MILL STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 507-2008 approving the 2009 Consolidated Action Plan including applications and certifications for the Community Development Block Grant (hereinafter Community Development), the HOME Investment Partnership (hereinafter HOME) and Emergency Shelter Grant (hereinafter ESG) Programs; authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into all necessary contracts for the operation and term of the Programs; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 508-2008 authorizing an amendment to the 2008 Consolidated Plan and Community Development/Home Program, to include the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) as an eligible activity; authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into all necessary agreements for the operation and term of the activities; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 509-2008 2. Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to solicit proposals, advertise for bids, and enter into contracts for the maintenance of various parks, traffic islands and miscellaneous City properties for 2009; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 510-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a mutual aid agreement with the City of Barberton, the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Metro SWAT, the University of Akron, the County of Summit and the Summit County Sheriff's Office regarding matters involving law enforcement; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 511-2008 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a grant agreement with the Office of National Drug Control Policy to reimburse the City of Akron for the cost of leasing seven vehicles for the Oho HIDTA (High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area) Program; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 512-2008 authorizing the expenditure of funds to purchase hospitality items for various Recreation Bureau activities; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 513-2008 urging Akron residents to become educated regarding the transition from analog to digital broadcast television on February 17, 2009; and declaring an emergency.
