

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 23, 2009

ORD. NO. 117-2009 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, after requesting proposals, for Professional Medical Liability Insurance for the Department of Health physicians; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 118-2009 approving the recommendations of the Tax Incentive Review Councils regarding the continuation, modification and/or cancellation of the enterprise zone and tax increment financing agreements in the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 119-2009 accepting a sewer easement for property described below for the WATERLOO ROAD WRIGHT SEWER JEDD project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 120-2009 approving the sale of City owned land to Lugene, Inc.; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 121-2009 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into a contract or contracts with non-profit organizations for the provision of public services in order to carry out the intent and purpose of programs under the Consolidated Plan for the year 2009; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 122-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of traffic signalization improvements on Cuyahoga Falls Avenue from Howard Street to Front Street; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 123-2009 declaring it necessary to improve Dover Avenue between the termini of Diagonal Road and Stoner Street, East Park Boulevard between the termini of Congo Street and the southern terminus, Genoa Avenue between the termini of Cluster Avenue and East Park Boulevard and Santee Avenue between the termini of South Arlington Street and Van Everett Avenue by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and water mains; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 124-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of improvements to Tech Way; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 125-2009 approving the terms of a preliminary financing summary relating to financing a portion of the costs of acquisition by IRG Rubber City, LLC of certain of the real estate comprising the campus of The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company located in the City; authorizing the Mayor to enter into, execute and deliver an amendment to the Development Agreement among the City, the County of Summit and IRG Rubber City, LLC; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 126-2009 authorizing the Director of Finance to make a donation in support of the AkronReads Program; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 127-2009 authorizing the Mayor to expend public monies for the Outstanding Employee Recognition Program for 2009; authorizing the Director of Finance to make payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 128-2009 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2009 Phase I Pavement Recycling Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets, and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 129-2009 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2009 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 130-2009 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2009 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 131-2009 declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2009 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 132-2009 determining to proceed with the improvement of Marigold Avenue between the termini of Catawba Avenue and Mission Street, Rockford Street between the termini of Marigold Avenue and Palmetto Avenue, East Rosewood Avenue between the termini of Rockford Street and Evergreen Avenue, Evergreen Avenue between the termini of East Rosewood Avenue and Catawba Avenue, Evergreen Circle between the termini of Evergreen Avenue and cul-de-sac, Sage Avenue between the termini of Crescent Avenue and the western terminus and Wilbeth Road between the termini of Dallas Avenue and 100 feet east of Dallas Avenue by constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewers and water mains; and resurfacing; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 133-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2009 Residential Resurfacing Program; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 134-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2009 Arterial Collector Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 135-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal and riser rings for various streets in the 2009 Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 136-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic rejuvenating agent for various streets in 2009 for the Construction Seal Program; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 137-2009 authorizing the Director of Law to enter into a contract with the Summit County Public Defender Commission to provide legal services for indigent defendants in Akron Municipal Court through the Legal Defenders Office of Summit County, Ohio, Inc.; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 138-2009 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Akron Symphony Orchestra to provide outdoor concerts at various locations throughout the City during 2009; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 139-2009 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Akron Art Museum for outdoor concerts in 2009; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 140-2009 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with professional dance companies and necessary contractors and specialty consultants to provide the Heinz Poll Summer Dance Festival to be held at various locations during the summer of 2009; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 141-2009 expressing support for City of Akron sponsorship of the National League of Cities Prescription Discount Card Program; and declaring an emergency.
