

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 11, 2009

ORD. NO. 201-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of repairs to various sidewalks throughout the City; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 202-2009 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into a contract with non-profit neighborhood based organizations for the provision of services in order to carry out the intent and purpose of the Neighborhood Partnership program; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 203-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of sidewalk and street improvements around the 22 Exchange Building; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 204-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of ADA compliant curb ramps; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 205-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the replacement of the State Street Bridge from South Main Street to Water Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 206-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the new Mill Street Bridge and approach roadway from Broadway to College Street; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 207-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contact, after publicly advertising for bids, for expansion of the parking lot at 401 South High Street; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 208-2009 authorizing the expenditure of funds to implement the 2009 Lock 3 Summer Arts Experience and Neighborhood Canvas Project; authorizing the Mayor to enter into contracts for professional services required for these programs; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 209-2009 authorizing the City of Akron to accept a deed from the Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company forfeiting its reversionary interest in Middlebury Run Park and convey Middlebury Run Park to IRG Rubber City, LLC or its designee for redevelopment in accordance with the Eastgate Urban Renewal Plan and the Eastgate 2 Urban Redevelopment Plan and the development agreement entered into between the City of Akron, the County of Summit and IRG Rubber City, LLC (Development Agreement"); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 210-2009 authorizing the Mayor to enter into, execute and deliver an amended preliminary financing summary relating to financing a portion of the costs of acquisition by IRG Rubber City LLC of certain of the real estate comprising the campus of The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company located in the City; authorizing the Mayor to enter into, execute and deliver an amendment to the Development Agreement and a Cooperative Agreement among the City, the County of Summit, the Summit County Port Authority and IRG Rubber City LLC and its affiliates; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 211-2009 urging the United Auto Workers, the State of Ohio, the City of Twinsburg, the Greater Akron Chamber and Team NEO to work together to save jobs at the Chrysler Stamping Plant and to do everything possible to keep those jobs at the Chrysler Stamping Plant in Twinsburg; and declaring an emergency.
