

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 15, 2009

ORD. NO. 259-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the removal and replacement of a crash attenuator on State Route 8 southbound at the central interchange; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 260-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with Finn Corporation for the repair of a truck mounted bark blower; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 261-2009 authorizing the Director of Health to enter into a personal services contract with Panethong Rassavong Lynum to provide Refugee Health Outreach Services; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 262-2009 authorizing the Director of Health to enter into an agreement with the International Institute to provide interpreter services for health screenings and related referrals; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 263-2009 amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 653-2000, passed October 23, 2000, which authorized a conditional use to establish offices and one dwelling unit on property at 1041 West Market Street, by changing the name and address of the Petitioner, changing Condition (2) regarding tenant, changing Condition (4) regarding signage, and deleting Condition (7) regarding property ownership; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 264-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the Catholic Youth Organization to provide recreational facilities and activities for the youth with physical disabilities; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 265-2009 authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to file an application with the United States Department of Energy for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program; to enter into all necessary contracts for the operation and term of the Program, and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 266-2009 expressing support for City of Akron participation in the Partnership for Youth Success (PaYS) Program developed by the U.S. Army to recruit young people interested in obtaining a quality civilian job after service the Army and urging area employers to participate in the Army PaYS program; and declaring an emergency.
