

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 14, 2009

ORD. NO. 344-2009 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an oversized garage at 1629 Hyde Park Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 345-2009 determining to proceed with the improvement of Barbara Avenue between the termini of Allendale Avenue and the eastern terminus by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and storm sewers; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 346-2009 Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of notes in a principal amount not exceeding \$9,200,000 to pay the property owners' portion, in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments, of the cost of improving certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 347-2009 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Finance to purchase miscellaneous supplies and services for various divisions of the departments of the City using "spot market pricing" for a period of three (3) years; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 348-2009 Resolution declaring it necessary to improve Girard Street between the termini of North Firestone Boulevard and Archwood Avenue by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and water mains; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 349-2009 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Waterloo Wright Sewer JEDD project; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 350-2009 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the renovation and expansion of the play area at Will Christy Park; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency

ORD. NO. 351-2009 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the design and construction of improvements to the I-76 Interchange Bridges at the west end of the central interchange; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 352-2009 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the design and construction of improvements to the East Leg of I-76 from the Central Interchange to Gilchrist Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 353-2009 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the design and construction of improvements to the Westbound exit ramp bridge over Broadway Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 354-2009 Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the design and construction of improvements to the Kenmore Leg of I-76; and declaring an emergency.
