

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED NOVEMBER 9, 2009

ORD. NO. 478-2009 approving the terms of a Consent Decree between the United States of America, the State of Ohio and the City to be entered as a final judgment in connection with litigation between the parties; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 479-2009 approving the 2010 Consolidated Action Plan and 2010-2014 Consolidated Strategy for Community Development/HOME and Emergency Shelter Grant Program; authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into all necessary agreements for the operation and term of the program; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 480-2009 authorizing a pledge of additional security for the City's issue of refunding bonds authorized in Ordinance No. 461-2009 for the purpose of refunding certain maturities of certain general obligation bonds issued in 1998, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2005, 2006 and 2007; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 481-2009 declaring it necessary to improve Baird Street between the termini of Brown Street and Burkhardt Avenue and Kipling Street between the termini of Brown Street and Burkhardt Avenue by resurfacing; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 482-2009 declaring it necessary to improve South Main Street between certain termini by paving; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, and driveway approaches; constructing and reconstructing storm sewers; installing roof drain pipes; installing pedestrian lighting; and planting trees and installing tree grates; designating the Improvement as eligible for the Small Business Assistance Program; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 483-2009 requesting the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation to increase the speed limit to 65 mph along IR 77 north of Vernon Odom Boulevard to Cleveland-Massillon Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 484-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the constructing of Sand Run Parkway Sewer Lining; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 485-2009 authorizing the Mayor to file a grant application and enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio, Office of Criminal Justice Service to receive overage money available for fiscal year 2009; authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement to accept funding from the 2009 Overage Grant; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 486-2009 approving and confirming the appointments of Virginia Robinson and Dr. Dennis C. McCluskey and the reappointment of Tracy Carter Johnson to the Akron Health Commission; and declaring an emergency.
