

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED DECEMBER 14, 2009

ORD. NO. 533-2009 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document (s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM S. MAIN STREET ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 534-2009 providing for zero increase in employee compensations within the Non-Bargaining, Management and Unclassified job classes; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 535-2009 amending Ordinance No. 97-2009, passed March 9, 2009 and Ordinance No. 449-2009, passed November 23, 2009, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2009; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 536-2009 providing for the temporary appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the period of January 1, 2010 through March 31, 2010; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 537-2009 determining to proceed with the improvement of Vernon Odom Boulevard between the termini of the west Corporation line and Romig Road and between the termini of Maxen Drive and Diana Avenue by resurfacing; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 538-2009 determining to proceed with the improvement of Hilbish Avenue between the termini of Triplett Boulevard and East Market Street by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes; installing street lighting; and planting trees; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 539-2009 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for construction of the Sanitary Sewer Reconstruction 2009 Project; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 540-2009 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Department of Homeland Security for funding for 38 firefighters from the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response program; authorizing the expenditure of local matching funds in support of the grant; authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement to implement this grant; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 541-2009 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the LITTLE CUYAHOGA RIVER RESTORATION project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.
