

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 22, 2010

ORD. NO. 92-2010 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the EDGEWOOD REDEVELOPMENT AREA project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 93-2010 approving the sale of City owned land to Urban Neighborhood Redevelopment Corporation; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 94-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to purchase two used vehicles at public auction; authorizing payment therefore; authorizing the resale of these vehicles at public auction when they are no longer needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 95-2010 authorizing the Director of Health to enter into a contract with Violet's Cupboard, Inc. for primary care services for persons living with HIV/AIDS in underserved communities; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 96-2010 adopting an annual operating budget for the fiscal year 2010; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 97-2010 To make the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2010; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 98-2010 approving and confirming the appointment of George A. Romanoski to the Akron Civil Service Commission; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 99-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute, on behalf of the City, an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of approximately 1.98 acres of City-owned street right-of-way along Midway Avenue, Ocean Avenue, and Scenic Way to Bass Energy for completion of the "HWA Unit No. 1" gas/oil well drilling unit unitization; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 100-2010 levying special assessments for the improvement of White Pond Drive between the termini of the Wheeling and Lake Erie Railroad track crossing and 500 feet north of Mull Avenue by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches and storm sewers; installing roof drain pipes; installing traffic signalization and street lighting; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 101-2010 authorizing the Mayor to file a grant application and enter into an agreement with the National Institute of Justice for funding to conduct "cold case" investigations where DNA evidence is involved; authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract to implement this grant; and declaring an emergency

RES. NO. 102-2010 supporting and endorsing Issue 16, a 1.4 mill levy for the Akron Summit County Public Library; and declaring an emergency.
