

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 28, 2010

ORD. NO. 208-2010 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM S. MAIN STREET WILBETH ROAD project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 209-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the replacement of the filter media in ten filter boxes at the Akron Water Plant and renovation of the filter beds; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 210-2010 amending and/or supplementing Title 3, Chapter 35, Section 35.02 "Working Hours", 35.03 "Sick Leave for Permanent Full Time Employees", 35.06 "Longevity Pay", and 35.11 "Clothing Allowance for Firemen", and approving changes in benefits for members of American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees Local #1360, and the Akron Firefighters Association Local #330; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 211-2010 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Kustom Signals, Inc. for the purchase of 19 in-car video camera systems, without the formality of advertising for bids; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 212-2010 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay \$15,000.00 for an operating subsidy to Cascade Locks Park Association; declaring this expenditure of funds to be in the public interest and for a public purpose.

ORD. NO. 213-2010 authorizing the Director of Finance to pay \$60,000 as an operating subsidy for the 2010 All-American Soap Box Derby; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 214-2010 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with the Akron/Summit Convention & Visitors Bureau for the operation of the convention bureau in 2010; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 215-2010 authorizing the Mayor to file applications and to enter into agreements for funding of certain capital improvements under the Ohio Public Works Commission's Local Transportation Improvement Program (LTIP) and the State Capital Improvements Program (SCIP); committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 216-2010 determining to proceed with the improvement of Carroll Street between certain termini by paving, constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks, and driveway approaches, constructing and reconstructing storm sewers and water mains, installing roof drain pipes, and planting trees and installing tree grates, all together with the necessary appurtenances, approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board, and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 217-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter to a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the cleanup and remediation of the Landmark Building; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 218-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Goodyear Fire Pump Reconnection; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 219-2010 determining to proceed with the improvement of Archwood Avenue and certain other streets between certain termini in accordance with Resolution No. 127-2010 passed April 26, 2010 (2010 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 220-2010 determining to proceed with the improvement of Anderson Avenue and certain other streets between certain termini in accordance with Resolution No. 128-2010 passed April 26, 2010 (2010 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 221-2010 determining to proceed with the improvement of Arch Street and certain other streets between certain termini in accordance with Resolution No. 129-2010 passed April 26, 2010 (2010 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 222-2010 determining to proceed with the improvement of Ada Street and certain other streets between certain termini in accordance with Resolution No. 130-2010 passed April 26, 2010 (2010 Phase I Pavement Recycling Resurfacing Program); and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 223-2010 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Development, for funding from the Clean Ohio Assistance Fund for the environmental assessment of Canal Place Buildings 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 17, located on the west side of South Main Street near the corner of West Bartges Street, known as 520 S. Main Street; and if funding is awarded, to enter into an agreement to implement the assessment; and declaring an emergency.
