

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 25, 2010

ORD. NO. 337-2010 amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 588-2007, passed on November 19, 2007, which amending Ordinance No. 414-1995, passed on June 26, 1995, which authorized a Conditional Use to permit the construction of a coffee house on property at 489 Brown Street by changing the name of the owner, by eliminating Condition (1) regarding use and eliminating Condition (13) regarding hours of operation; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 338-2010 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the Northside Train Station Connector project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 339-2010 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the C.D. LAND BANKING project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 340-2010 authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service, and/or the Director of Finance to purchase miscellaneous supplies and repair parts and labor for machinery and equipment used by various divisions of the departments of the City for a period of one (1) year; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 341-2010 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in contracting with Kenmore Construction, Inc. for emergency repair of a 36 inch water main and associated clean-up on Glenwood Avenue near N. Howard Street; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 342-2010 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Massillon Road Sewer; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 343-2010 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Motorola Communications for maintenance of 12 gold Elite consoles and associated central electronics banks dispatch site for a period covering September 1, 2010 through August 31, 2011; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 344-2010 authorizing the Mayor to assist Trelleborg Wheel Systems Americas, Inc. in creating jobs within the City of Akron by entering into a grant agreement; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 345-2010 amending and/or supplementing Section 35.14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Akron to address the longevity compensation for management and non-bargaining unit employees for the calendar year 2010; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 346-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$1,130,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, for the purpose of paying costs of acquiring and equipping motor vehicles for various Divisions in the City; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 347-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$8,605,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, to retire notes issued for the purpose of paying the costs of various capital improvements in the City; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 348-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$52,795,000, for the purpose of retiring notes issued to pay costs of various capital improvements in the City; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 349-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$74,660,000, for the purpose of refunding certain maturities of general obligation bonds issued in 1998, 2001, 2002, and 2003; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 350-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$7,625,000, for the purpose of refunding certain maturities of pension bonds issued in 1999; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 351-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$22,780,000, for the purpose of refunding waterworks system special revenue bonds issued in 2000 and 2002; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 352-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$18,080,000, for the purpose of refunding sanitary sewer system special revenue bonds issued in 2000 and 2002; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 353-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$1,050,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, for the purpose of paying costs of improving the municipal parks and recreational system by construction, improving, and equipping parks and recreational facilities within the City; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 354-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$4,500,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, for the purpose of paying costs of constructing, reconstructing, resurfacing, and otherwise improving certain arterial/collector streets, residential streets, bridges, and sidewalks within the City; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 355-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$100,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, for the purpose of paying the costs of constructing and improving public improvements in connection with certain economic development projects for commercial/industrial development, downtown development, and neighborhood business district development; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 356-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$165,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, for the purpose of paying the costs of constructing and improving storm sewers and storm sewerage facilities within the City; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 357-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of notes in a maximum principal amount of \$6,320,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, for the purpose of paying costs of constructing, reconstructing, paving, resurfacing, grading, and otherwise improving off-street parking facilities; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 358-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$200,000, in anticipation of the issuance of bonds, for the purpose of paying the costs of improving municipal buildings and facilities by constructing, reconstructing, renovating, restoring, remodeling, making site and other improvements, and acquiring and installing related equipment; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 359-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of recovery zone economic development bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$4,550,000, for the purpose of paying costs of constructing, reconstructing, resurfacing, and otherwise improving certain arterial/collector streets and sidewalks, including the installation and replacing of traffic signalization within the City; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 360-2010 authorizing the issuance and sale of recovery zone economic development bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$2,850,000, for the purpose of paying costs of constructing, renovating, and otherwise improving municipal buildings; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 361-2010 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio for funding from the FFY 2011 High Visibility Enforcement Overtime Grant; authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract to implement the grant; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 362-2010 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Brite Computers for the purchase of net motion mobility 9.0 mobile VPN licenses; without the formality of advertising for bids; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 363-2010 authorizing the Mayor to lease a portion of the docking area at 1085 Sweitzer Avenue to Polyflow LLC, for the purpose of job retention and to promote private investment and economic development; and declaring an emergency.
