

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JANUARY 24, 2011

ORD. NO. 4-2011 accepting conveyance(s) by deed of estates in fee simple of property in the City of Akron, for the Sum S. Main Street Wilbeth Road project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 5-2011 approving the transfer of City owned land to Neighborhood Development Services; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 6-2011 accepting Various Right-of-Way Document(s) for certain property described below to facilitate the completion of the SUM-Massillon Road Improvements project; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 7-2011 approving and authorizing the execution of a Purchase or Lease Option Agreement with Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority (“AMHA”), providing for an option to purchase or lease certain City owned property; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 8-2011 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the Johnston Street Yard Emergency Power Generator; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 9-2011 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the widening of State Road from Bath Road to Steels Corners Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 10-2011 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Kenmore Construction Company for the emergency repair of street pavement on West Exchange Street at Portage Path; authorizing payment therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 11-2011 providing for adjustments in employee compensation for the uniformed members of the Division of Police; amending and/or supplementing Title 3, Section 35.01 “Working Hours”; and approving changes in medical benefits and fitness allowances for members of the Fraternal Order of Police, Akron Lodge #7; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 12-2011 authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to file an application and enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio for funding of capital improvements for the Adams Run Trail and Greenway project through the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund; committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 13-2011 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of required uniform items for Fire Division members; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 14-2011 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with MapSys for the purchase of two Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) servers, including five years of support and maintenance, and to enter into a contract with Rocket U2 for Unidata software required for the CAD databases, without the formality of advertising for bids; and declaring an emergency.
