

## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 6, 2013

**ORD. NO. 131-2013** authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement for funding of airport improvements through the State of Ohio's FY2014 Ohio Airport Grant Program; committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 132-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and/or lease of various equipment used in daily operations of City departments; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 133-2013** authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract for the purchase of a Quint fire truck from the Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program for FY2012 administered by the Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency; authorizing payment of the local share; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 134-2013** authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract for the purchase of twelve lead heart monitors, hydraulic extrication equipment, and highway safety equipment from the Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program for FY2012 administered by the Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency; authorizing payment of the local share; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 135-2013** opposing an Amendment to H.B. 59, the Ohio House of Representatives' 2013-2014 Biennial Budget Bill, which adds an additional judge to the Summit County Court of Common Pleas, Juvenile Division; urging the Ohio Senate and Governor to act to eliminate this provision from the final version of the 2013-2014 State Biennial Budget; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 136-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal and riser rings for various streets in the 2013 Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 137-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2013 Arterial Collector Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 138-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2013 Residential Resurfacing Program, including alternates; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 139-2013** declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2013 Phase I Residential Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 140-2013** declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2013 Phase I Arterial/Collector Resurfacing Program) by resurfacing such streets with asphaltic concrete 402/404, and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 141-2013** declaring it necessary to improve certain streets between certain termini (2013 Phase I Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program) by treating the surface thereof with substances designed to preserve the surface, and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 142-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to file an application and enter into a contract with the Ohio Air Quality Development Authority for an Air Quality Control Loan to help fund energy efficiency and conservation improvements to City facilities; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 143-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an Energy Savings Facilities Performance Contract with Honeywell International, Inc. for the implementation of energy efficient improvements to City facilities; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 144-2013** authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with Oriana House, Inc. for confinement, rehabilitation services and alternative sentencing options for offenders convicted of Akron Code violations; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 145-2013** congratulating LeBron James on receiving the 2013 NBA's Most Valuable Player Award; expressing appreciation for his continuing civic and charitable involvement in the Akron community; and declaring an emergency.
