

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 20, 2013

ORD. NO. 152-2013 authorizing the purchase of properties and accepting the donation of property for the C.D. Land Banking Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 153-2013 purchasing a Right-of-Way to facilitate the completion of the Sum Englewood Avenue Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 154-2013 approving the sale of City-owned land located at 794 (V.L.) Noble Avenue to Beatrice Lewis, determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 155-2013 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of the Firestone/Litchfield Community Learning Center at 333 Rampart Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 156-2013 amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 235-1994, passed on April 4, 1994, which approved the site plan for Walgreen's Drugstore at 1303 Copley Road, by adding an additional site plan for a canopy; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 157-2013 directing the appropriation of fee simple interests, a permanent sewer easement, permanent utility easements, permanent aerial easements and temporary construction easements in certain real property owned by General Street Business Park Ltd., located on Seiberling Street and Englewood Avenue, for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public in conjunction with the SUM/Englewood Avenue Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06 (B) for the purposes of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 158-2013 declaring it necessary to improve various off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, repairing and replacing retaining walls, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and all when and where necessary; and declaring an emergency.
