

## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 11, 2013

**RES. NO. 62-2013** adopting an annual operating budget for the fiscal year 2013; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 63-2013** to make the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2013; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 64-2013** authorizing a Conditional Use to vary the building line to construct an internally illuminated changeable copy sign at 1175 West Market Street; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 65-2013** amending/supplementing Title 15, Chapter 153, "Zoning Code" Section 153.530 "Class UPD-11 District", to change the height requirements and placement of on-site trash storage; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 66-2013** approving an amendment to the Eastgate Urban Renewal Plan so as to expand the UPD-11 District Classification boundary, and to clarify the height requirement and development requirements; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 67-2013** approving an amendment to the Eastgate II Redevelopment Plan to correct text omissions and change boundaries by amending Map 7; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 68-2013** amending The Zoning Map by changing the Two-Family Residence Use District (U1, H1, A2); Retail Business Use District (U3, H1, A3); Commercial Use District (U4, H1, A1); (U4, H1, A3) (U4, H1, A4), (U4, H2, A2)(U4, H2, A3), (U4, H3, A4); and Ordinary Industry Use District (U5, H2, A3), (U5, H3, A2), (U5, H3, A4), and (U5, H4, A1) Classification on property generally bounded Laird Street to the north, I-76 to the south, Wheeling and Lake Erie railroad tracks to the east, and South Case Street to the west, to a UPD-11 District Classification; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 69-2013** amending and/or supplementing Title 7 "Traffic Code," Chapter 73 "Motor Vehicle Crimes," Article 2 "Reckless Operation" to include a ban on sending, reading or writing a text message or accessing the internet while driving; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 70-2013** amending and/or supplementing Title 15 "Land Usage," Chapter 150 "Environmental Health Housing Code," and amending and/or supplementing Title 19 "Building Code," Chapter 190 "General Provisions," by requiring an owner to disclose notice of violations to potential buyers; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 71-2013** authorizing the Mayor to publish a commemoration book and expend funds for the purchase of awards, food, and other items for the City of Akron Holocaust Commemoration; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 72-2013** authorizing the Department of Law to take actions necessary to protect the taxpayers of the City from potential claims and to assist Lawrence Modic if he requests and consents in writing to bring an action against those who may have failed to disclose housing code violations prior to selling him the property located at 1480 Manchester Road; and declaring an emergency.
