

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 29, 2013

ORD. NO. 250-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute, on behalf of the City, an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of approximately 7.93 acres of City-owned land and street rights-of-way for completion of the “J.J. & J Unit No. 1-D” gas/oil well drilling unitization at 1300 Triplett Boulevard; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 251-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to execute, on behalf of the City, an oil and/or gas lease agreement for the mineral rights of approximately 27.73 acres of City-owned land and street rights-of-way for completion of the “Bishop Unit #1-D and Bishop Unit #2” gas/oil well drilling unitizations at 585 Cuyahoga Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 252-2013 authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into an agreement with the Urban Neighborhood Development Corporation (UNDC) to provide for the construction and sale of moderate cost single-family homes on a non-profit basis within the Community Development Activity Area; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 253-2013 approving and confirming the appointments of Donald Plusquellic, Marco Sommerville, John Moore, Helen Tomic, Councilman Russell Neal, Councilman Bob Hoch, and Councilman Michael Williams as members of the Northeast Ohio Four County Regional Planning and Development Organization; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 254-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for construction of the Mud Run Pump Station and Storage Basin and related improvements; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 255-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for reconstruction of the Sevilla Sanitary Trunk Sewer and related improvements; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 256-2013 authorizing a Conditional Use to permit the construction of a pool house at 118 South Canton Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 257-2013 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an apartment building at 1148 West Market Street, and to construct a parking lot at 1250 West Exchange Street; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 258-2013 acknowledging the heroic efforts of Kameron Williams, Kaila Watkins and Phil Watkins in attempting to rescue Nic Shaffer from the Mud Brook Creek; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 259-2013 approving and confirming the appointment of Jeff Fusco to the board of directors of the Coventry-Akron, Springfield-Akron, Bath-Akron-Fairlawn, and Copley-Akron Joint Economic Development Districts; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 260-2013 levying special assessments and determining to proceed with the improvement of various off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same and all when and where necessary; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 261-2013 withdrawing an objection to the application for permit renewal to Al C. Sanders, Akron Ohio for a Class D2 liquor permit (0090375) not pending before the Division of Liquor Control; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 262-2013 amending and/or supplementing Title 9 “General Provisions,” Chapter 97 “Air Pollution Control,” Section 97.41 “Phosphates,” to amend phosphate detergent regulations to be consistent with regulations of the State of Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 263-2013 congratulating Laraine Duncan on her many years of exemplary service to the City of Akron and wishing her well in her retirement; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 264-2013 congratulating Richard A. Merolla on his many years of exemplary service to the City of Akron and wishing him well in his retirement; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 265-2013 congratulating Ronnie Williamson on his many years of exemplary service to the City of Akron and wishing him well in his retirement; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 266-2013 urging the Akron Civil Service Commission to review, study and modify its policies and civil services rules concerning fair hiring practices in order to provide an opportunity for qualified, redeemed convicted individuals to seek employment with the City of Akron based on their own merit; and declaring an emergency.
