**ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 23, 2013**

**ORD. NO. 275-2013** Ordinance accepting property by donation for the C.D. Land Banking Project; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 276-2013** approving the sale of City owned land to Danielle S. Pegues Williams & Barry Pegues; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 277-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of ADA compliant curb ramps; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 278-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of repairs to various sidewalks throughout the City; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 279-2013** ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Cardinal Environmental Services, Inc., and Belfore USA for emergency basement cleanup assistance at various properties within the City; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 280-2013** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with Brite Computers for the renewal of NetMotion Software, without the formality of advertising for bids; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 281-2013** authorizing a Conditional Use to install two brine wells west of Manchester Road, south of the Tuscarawas River; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 282-2013** authorizing a Conditional Use to construct an addition at 40 East Glenwood Avenue; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 283-2013** approving the historic designation of 1200 Firestone Parkway and 1301 South Main Street (Firestone Tire and Rubber Company) as a historic landmark; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 284-2013** authorizing the Director of Finance to pay \$750 towards the purchase of an Ohio Historical Marker to commemorate the historical importance of the Akron Community Service Center and Urban League; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 285-2013** approving the historic designation of Greystone Hall at 103 South High Street as an historic landmark; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 286-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with Greystone Partners for the lease of City-owned property at 103 South High Street known as Greystone Hall; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 287-2013** authorizing the purchase of utility easements and property for the Ohio Canal Interceptor Tunnel Project; and declaring an emergency.
