

AKRON, OHIO COUNCIL
ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED OCTOBER 21, 2013

ORD. NO. 309-2013 authorizing the purchase of property for the C.D. Land Banking Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 310-2013 approving the sale of City owned land to Subcontractors Association of N.E. Ohio; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 311-2013 authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a solid fence at 128 South Canton Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 312-2013 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish a mixed use development at 243 Furnace Street; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 313-2013 approving the 2014 Consolidated Action Plan including applications and certifications for the Community Development Block Grant (“Community Development”), the HOME Investment Partnership (“HOME”) and Emergency Solutions Grant (“ESG”) Programs; authorizing the Director of Planning and Urban Development to enter into all necessary contracts for the operation and term of the Programs; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 314-2013 authorizing an amendment to an Amended and Restated Lease-Purchase Agreement and a supplement to an Amended and Restated Trust Agreement, both relating to the outstanding Refunding Certificates of Participation, Series 2005 and authorizing the refunding of all or a portion of the outstanding Refunding Certificates of Participation, Series 2005, by providing for the issuance, sale and delivery of Taxable Refunding Certificates of Participation, Series 2013, and authorizing and approving other documents relating to the refunding; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 315-2013 authorizing an amendment to an Amended and Restated Lease-Purchase Agreement and a supplement to an Amended and Restated Trust Agreement and providing for the issuance, sale and delivery of Certificates of Participation, Series 2013, and authorizing and approving other documents related thereto; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 316-2013 authorizing the Director of Finance to enter into an agreement with The University of Akron School of Law to provide an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for the expungement program; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 317-2013 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in real property owned by Pete T. Georgekopoulos (aka Pete Georgekopoulos) located at 1004 East Exchange Street, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in connection with the CSO Racks 5 and 7 Storage Basin Project; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 318-2013 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a permanent utility easement in real property owned by Enlarging Arts, Inc. located at 145 Tarbell Street, for the purposes of constructing, maintaining, repairing, enlarging, and reconstructing a sewer or sewers and waterlines for drainage, sewerage and waterline purposes in connection with the Ohio Canal Interceptor Tunnel Project; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 319-2013 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement for funding from the FY2013 COPS Hiring Program administered through the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services, to provide funding to hire law enforcement officers to increase the community’s policing capacity and crime-prevention efforts; and declaring an emergency.
