

AKRON, OHIO COUNCIL
ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED DECEMBER 9, 2013

ORD. NO. 363-2013 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with MapSys Systems & Solutions for consulting services for the Akron Municipal Court; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 364-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for relocation of the Water Distribution Yard, approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 365-2013 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Water Department Authority (OWDA) for a loan for the planning, design and construction of the Water Distribution Yard relocation; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 366-2013 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into contracts for the purchase of four leased vehicles for use in the Akron Police Department; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 367-2013 amending Ordinance No. 63-2013, passed March 11, 2013, Ordinance No. 227-2013, passed July 15, 2013, and Ordinance No. 301-2013, passed October 7, 2013 which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2013 and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 368-2013 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish an office, print shop, and warehouse at 1518 Copley Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 369-2013 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a 60-unit apartment building on the east side of Brownstown Avenue, south of Longstone Avenue.

ORD. NO. 370-2013 approving the sale of 4.0207 acres of City-owned land located on the east side of Brownstone Avenue, south of Longstone Avenue, to Testa Enterprises, determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 371-2013 approving and authorizing the execution of a contract for the acquisition of property owned by George George to establish a park or provide open space; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 372-2013 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Commons at Madaline Park, LLC to permit the construction of a water line and sewer improvements on and near Brownstone Avenue and accepting a dedication plat for a utility right-of-way for Madaline Park from the east side of Brownstone Avenue approximately 466 feet eastward; and declaring an emergency.

RES. NO. 373-2013 expressing support for the application of the Commons at Madaline Park II, LLC for the Commons at Madaline Park II Tax Credit Development; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 374-2013 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Summit County Health District for the provision of public health services to the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 375-2013 approving the site plan for Sterling Jewelers to construct an office addition at 375 Ghent Road; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 376-2013 approving the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District Petition and the plan for services to be provided by the Downtown Akron Special Improvement District, Inc.; and declaring an emergency.

ORD. NO. 377-2013 declaring the necessity of, determining to proceed with, and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City by constructing, reconstructing and repairing concrete sidewalks, driveway approaches, curbs and retaining walls and installing roof drain pipes; all in accordance with petitions submitted by property owners under the 2012 City-Wide Sidewalk Program; and declaring an emergency.
