

**AKRON, OHIO COUNCIL**

**ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED DECEMBER 16, 2013**

**ORD. NO. 378-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, the purchase of five 42 inch pipe spools for use at the Water Reclamation Facility; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 379-2013** authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract with North American Switchgear, Inc. for the purchase and installation of one remanufactured Westinghouse DS-420 circuit breaker and to recondition two existing DS-420 circuit breakers for use at the Akron Water Plant; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 380-2013** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Gray Matter Systems for the purchase of a GE iFix Global Care Complete software support package; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 381-2013** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the disposal of miscellaneous “white goods”, approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 382-2013** authorizing the Mayor to enter into a loan guaranty agreement with the Valley Savings Bank and University Park Alliance; and declaring an emergency.

**ORD. NO. 383-2013** approving and authorizing the execution of a contract for sale of land for private redevelopment with Rubber City Arches Main and Broadway, LLC, or its designee (the “Redeveloper”), providing for the sale and redevelopment of property; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 384-2013** urging the United States government to immediately take appropriate steps to assist in the unification of Ireland; and declaring an emergency.

**RES. NO. 385-2013** expressing appreciation to Ward 5 Councilman Kenneth L. Jones for his outstanding service to the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.
