ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 24, 2014:

ORD. NO. 40-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising, to replace a pump and motor at the West High Booster Station; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. **(VOTE: 13-0)**

ORD. NO. 41-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the relocation of Johnston Street between Spicer and Brown Street and improvements to I76; and declaring an emergency. **(VOTE: 13-0)**

ORD. NO. 42-2014 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Water Development Authority ("OWDA") for a loan for improvements along Kingswood and Rocky Hollow; and declaring an emergency. **(VOTE: 13-0)**

ORD. NO. 43-2014 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Kenmore Construction company for emergency repair of the retaining wall along the canal at Lock 3; and declaring an emergency. **(VOTE: 13-0)**

ORD. NO. 44-2014 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with H.M. Miller Construction for emergency repairs of the Towpath Trail along the Little Cuyahoga River north of Maple Street; and declaring an emergency. **(VOTE: 13-0)**

ORD. NO. 45-2014 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, to provide ADA access to the East Chemical Building and Low Lift Building at the Akron Water Plant; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. **(VOTE: 13-0)**

RES. NO. 46-2014 congratulating Captain Martha Sullivan on her many years of dedicated service to the City of Akron Police Department and wishing her well in her retirement; and declaring an emergency. **(VOTE: 13-0)**

RES. NO. 47-2014 supporting the Gay Games on August 9-16, 2014 in venues around the Akron and Cleveland area; and declaring an emergency. **(VOTE: 11-2 ;Freeman and Hurley)**
