ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 8, 2014:

ORD. NO. 257-2014 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a residential/mixed use development at 21 West North Street; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 258-2014 accepting a vacation plat for a portion of Furnace Street, north of the railroad tracks; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 259-2014 approving the sale of City-owned land to Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 260-2014 approving the sale of City-owned land to Gerald Hilton, Barbara J. Thrash, Cynthia P. Proffitt, Harry Boivin, Jr., Carol Boivin, and Jamie Young; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

RES. NO. 261-2014 declaring it necessary to improve Wilbeth Road between the termini of Dallas Avenue and Interstate 77 by paving; grading; constructing and reconstructing curbs, concrete sidewalks and driveway approaches; installing roof drain pipes; and planting trees; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 262-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the construction of the Interstate 76 Kenmore Leg Resurfacing project; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 263-2014 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the construction of the Chester Street Pedestrian Bridge project; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 264-2014 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into a grant agreement for funding from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, through the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Assistance to Firefighters Program, and to enter into a contract to implement the grant agreement; authorizing the expenditure of local matching funds; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

RES. NO. 265-2014 opposing the parole of convicted murderer Charles Jennings who is serving a life sentence for the murder of Akron Police Officer Eugene Hooper and the assault on Officer Frank Mancini and Reserve Officer Harold Wintrow, and urging the Ohio parole Board to deny his bid for release; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*
