



# CITY OF AKRON, OHIO

## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED DECEMBER 8, 2014:

**ORD. NO. 370-2014** authorizing the Mayor, the Director of Public Service and or the Director of Finance to enter into contracts, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of materials and services needed by the various City departments for a period of time not to exceed 3 years; approving the specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 371-2014** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Health & Fitness Equipment Centers, for the purchase of fitness equipment for the Balch Street Community Center; approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 372-2014** amending Ordinance No. 75-2014, passed March 17, 2014, Ordinance No. 210-2014, passed July 14, 2014 and Ordinance No. 334-2014, passed October 27, 2014, which established the annual appropriation for the current expenses, other expenditures and the capital outlays of the City of Akron for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2014; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 373-2014** authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a telecommunications tower at 751 East North Street; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 374-2014** authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with 285 Place Limited, LLC for the purchase of property located at 283 South Main Street; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 11-2 (Mosley-Samples and Williams voted no)***

**RES. NO. 375-2014** urging Congress to pass Senate Bill 2839, the “Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act of 2014”, to expand research and services to fight drug addiction; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0 (Freeman left the meeting)***

**RES. NO. 376-2014** urging Congress to pass legislation enacting the “Body Worn Camera Partnership Program” proposed by President Obama to fund the purchase of body camera equipment for local law enforcement agencies, requesting the grant of funds to the City of Akron for that purpose; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0 (Freeman left the meeting)***
