ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MAY 4, 2015:

ORD. NO. 119-2015 approving the transfer of various city properties and the sale of 963-993 S. Main Street to the State of Ohio for the I76-I77 Main/Broadway Interchange Project; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 120-2015 approving the sale of 484 Marview Ave. to Rita Noble; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring it an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 121-2015 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with White Hot Properties, LLC for the purchase of property located at 237, 241, and 243 Furnace Street (the "Property"); authorizing payment therefore; approving and authorizing the execution of a Contract for Sale of Land for Private Redevelopment, providing for the sale and redevelopment of the Property to Whitespace Design Group, Inc. pursuant to the Furnace Street Urban Renewal Area Renewal Plan; finding such property is not needed for any public use and related findings; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 122-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract with the County of Summit for their participation in the 2015 Street Resurfacing Program, in which the County will share in the cost of improving streets that run along and partially outside the corporate limits of the City; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 123-2015 amending and/or supplementing Title 9 "General Provisions," Chapter 98 "Streets and Sidewalks," Section 98.05 "Sidewalk cafes," to modify the renewal permit fee for a sidewalk cafe; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 124-2015 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement for funding of airport improvements through the State of Ohio's FY2016 Ohio Airport Grant Program; committing City funds for the local share of these improvements; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 125-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal and riser rings for various streets in the 2015 Unimproved Street Resurfacing Program, including alternates, approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 126-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2015 Residential Resurfacing Program, including alternates, approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 127-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and application of asphaltic concrete, pavement removal, and riser rings for various streets in the 2015 Arterial Collector Program, including alternates, approving specifications therefore; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 128-2015 ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with H.M. Miller Construction Company for the emergency repair of 12-inch water main under the Tallmadge Avenue Bridge over Route 8; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 129-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the removal and installation of windows at the Water Supply Plant; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 130-2015 authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the County of Summit for the installation, connection, and lease of fiber lines owned by the City of Akron, to enable a network data connection from the County's core network at the Ohio Building to its new offices at 1180 South Main Street; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

ORD. NO. 131-2015 approving and authorizing the acquisition of land from Akron Metropolitan Housing Authority (AMHA); authorizing payment therefor; approving and authorizing the execution of a Contract for Sale of Land for Private Redevelopment with CMD Moon, LLC, providing for the sale and redevelopment of property pursuant to the Edgewood Urban Renewal Area Plan, as amended; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***

RES. NO. 132-2015 declaring the City of Akron to be an immigrant-friendly, welcoming City and supporting the City's participation in the Welcoming Cities and Counties Project and the WE Global Network; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 12-0***
