ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JUNE 1, 2015:

ORD. NO. 149-2015 authorizing the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a license agreement with Document Technology Services for OnBase advanced capture and imaging software; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 150-2015 approving the sale of a vacant lot on Sumner St. to Akron Mon Community; determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 151-2015 authorizing a Conditional Use to establish rock crushing of existing materials at 301-321 West Waterloo Road. *VOTE: 12-0*

RES. NO. 152-2015 acknowledging the impending vacancy in the office of Tenth Ward Council representative due to the succession of Council President Garry Moneypenny as Mayor of the City of Akron upon the resignation of Mayor Donald L. Plusquellic; providing for and setting June 15, 2015 as the date of the election by Council to fill the Tenth Ward vacancy; expressing appreciation to President Moneypenny for his service as Councilman of the Tenth Ward and as President of Council; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

RES. NO. 153-2015 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in certain real property owned by STADCO, Inc., consisting of vacant land and located on Young Street, for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public, without charge, in conjunction with the SUM-Evans Ave. Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code Section 163.06(B) for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public, without charge; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

ORD. NO. 154-2015 authorizing the Mayor to apply for and enter into a 2015 Justice Assistance Grant through the Bureau of Justice Assistance to develop and enhance programs to improve the criminal justice system; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*

RES. NO. 155-2015 congratulating the Cleveland Cavaliers on winning the National Basketball Association (NBA) Eastern Conference Championship under the leadership of LeBron James; wishing them success in the NBA Finals against the Golden State Warriors; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-0*
