



CITY OF AKRON, OHIO

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JULY 6, 2015:

ORD. NO. 194-2015 approving and authorizing the execution of a Contract for Lease of Land for Private Redevelopment, providing for the lease and redevelopment of property on Triplett Boulevard to FPR Properties, LLC, or its designee; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 195-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of the I-76 Extraordinary Maintenance project; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 196-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation for maintenance of the interstate system within Akron's municipal corporation limits; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 197-2015 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase and installation of four open protocol control boards for the Laboratory HVAC at the Water Supply Plant; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 198-2015 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with Shultz Fluid Handling Equipment for the purchase of two gear boxes and one electric motor for the Water Supply Plant; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

ORD. NO. 199-2015 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a drive-up ATM at 1883-1889 West Market Street. (PC-2015-29-CU) (D-219) *VOTE: 13-0*

RES. NO. 200-2015 declaring the necessity and intent of the City of Akron to appropriate a fee simple interest in certain real property owned by MJL Enterprises, LLC, located on 450 Hickory Street, for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public, without charge, in conjunction with the Hickory Street Road Improvements Project that is part of the Ohio Canal Interceptor Tunnel Project; declaring the necessity and intention of the City of Akron to proceed under Ohio Revised Code, Section 163.06 (B) for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, making or repairing roads that are open to the public without charge; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 12-1 (Williams voted no)*
