ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED SEPTEMBER 14, 2015:

ORD. NO. 247-2015 reaffirming support and authorizing execution of an amended and restated Guaranty Agreement among the City, the County of Summit and Fifth Third Bank, in connection with the extension of certain credit facilities to Akron Community Service Center and Urban League, Inc. (the “Akron Urban League”) to continue to support the Akron Urban League’s community service center and for its operations; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 248-2015 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into contracts with non-profit organizations, for the provision of public services in order to carry out the intent and purpose of programs under the Consolidated Plan for the year 2015; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 10-0 (Neal abstained)**

ORD. NO. 249-2015 approving the sale of City-owned land located at 704 Palisades Drive to Sarah Catherine Teixeira & Richard H. Teixeira, determining said property is not needed for public use; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 250-2015 accepting a vacation plat for an un-named irregularly shaped alley, consisting of approximately 0.2 acres, extending westward from North Hawkins Avenue, north of West Market Street; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 251-2015 authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into agreements with local agencies to carry out the Emergency Solutions Grant Program for program year 2015; authorizing payment therefor; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 252-2015 determining to proceed with and levying special assessments for the improvement of certain streets in the City, between certain termini, by providing street-cleaning services and street lighting; approving the report of the Assessment Equalization Board; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 253-2015 levying special assessments and determining to proceed with the improvement of various off-street parking facilities in the Kenmore Business District and the Canton Road Business District by sealing, resurfacing and repairing, painting parking space stripes, sweeping, removing snow, cleaning sewer openings, providing lawn, turf, shrub and tree maintenance, litter and other general clean-up and otherwise improving and maintaining the same, and all when and where necessary; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 254-2015 authorizing the Mayor, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the purchase of labor and materials to refurbish one medical unit for the Fire Division; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

ORD. NO. 255-2015 authorizing the Mayor, through the office of the Purchasing Agent, without the formality of advertising for bids, to enter into a contract for the purchase of various equipment for the Fire Division; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**

RES. NO. 256-2015 expressing the sincere appreciation of the City of Akron to Robert Ross for his years of dedicated service to the Fire Department and the City, wishing him well in his retirement; and declaring an emergency. **VOTE: 11-0**
