



# CITY OF AKRON, OHIO

## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED FEBRUARY 29, 2016:

**ORD. NO. 45-2016** approving and confirming the appointments of Mayor Daniel Horrigan, Councilman Zack Milkovich, and Diane Miller-Dawson as trustees to the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority Board and Jim Hall, Robert Harris and Cindy Donel as their respective alternates, for terms ending February 28, 2019; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**ORD. NO. 46-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the resurfacing of the aircraft parking and maneuvering areas of the Akron Fulton Airport, in accordance with FAA requirements, utilizing grant funding from the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) Office of Aviation; approving specifications therefor; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**ORD. NO. 47-2016** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to purchase labor and materials from the Ohio Edison Company, through the Efficiency Safety Incentive Program, for the maintenance of street lights in the City, in order to allow the City to obtain a favorable rate on these services and enhance safety in our neighborhoods; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**ORD. NO. 48-2016** authorizing the Mayor or his designee to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, for the purchase of fiber optic cabling to connect the Mud Run Sewer Pump Station to the City's fiber optic network; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**ORD. NO. 49-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the construction of White Pond Parkway to provide access into the proposed West Side Office Park; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**ORD. NO. 50-2016** authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into contracts with Montrose Ford, Cenweld Corporation and Fallsway Equipment Company for the replacement and refurbishment of a Water Maintenance Inspection Vehicle for the Water Distribution Division; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**ORD. NO. 51-2016** ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with H.M. Miller Construction Company for the emergency repair of the 12-inch water main on Hudson-Aurora Road in Hudson; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**ORD. NO. 52-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, for the purchase of spare Primary Tank flight parts for annual Primary Tank rebuilds at the Water Reclamation Facility; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**ORD. NO. 53-2016** approving, with modification, the renewal application of Raymond E. Zazo to have agricultural property at 1669 Copley Road placed in an “agricultural district” pursuant to Revised Code Section 929.01, *et seq.*; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 54-2016** amending and/or supplementing Ordinance No. 721-1994, passed on September 19, 1994, which permitted the establishment of a day care business center on property at 1010 South Hawkins Avenue; by changing the name of the Petitioner and eliminating Condition No. 12; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 55-2016** approving and authorizing the execution of an Agreement for Exchange of Real Property for Private Redevelopment, providing for the transfer and redevelopment of property on Broadway Street to the Akron Art Museum, pursuant to the Downtown Area Redevelopment Plan; finding such property is not needed for any public use, and related findings; approving the acceptance of property on Broadway Street and High Street by the City; all to facilitate the Akron Art Museum’s construction of the Bud and Susie Rogers Garden, a groundbreaking, outdoor community gallery space, designed using the concept of creative placemaking to drive civic engagement and economic development in Downtown Akron; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**ORD. NO. 56-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to file applications and enter into grant agreements for funding from the Safe Routes to School Program through the Ohio Department of Transportation, in order to implement infrastructure improvements and provide programming that will encourage and enable students to walk or bike to school; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**RES. NO. 57-2016** expressing opposition to Senate Bill 270, which would amend the Ohio Revised Code to significantly weaken reporting requirements for pawnbrokers and restrict the ability of law enforcement to share information between jurisdictions and utilize valuable electronic reporting systems like LeadsOnline, making it more difficult for law enforcement agencies to locate stolen goods and prosecute theft crimes; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**RES. NO. 58-2016** expressing support for Issue 2, the proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Akron that will consolidate all matters of personnel, employee relations, and employee health and welfare within a Department of Human Resources, under the administration of a Director of Human Resources; urging the citizens of Akron to vote “Yes” on Issue 2 at the March 15, 2016 election, in order to support organized and effective advances in human resources and employee relations for the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

**RES. NO. 59-2016** expressing support for Issue 1, the proposed ordinance that will grant the City of Akron the authority to aggregate the retail natural gas loads located in the City; urging the citizens of Akron to vote “Yes” on Issue 1 at the March 15, 2016 election, in order to allow the City to work with a gas supplier to develop a customized purchasing program to meet the needs of Akron residents; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***
