ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED JANUARY 25, 2016:

ORD. NO. 7-2016 authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract, without the formality of advertising for bids, with MapSys Systems & Solutions for a document imaging and management software program for the Clerk of the Akron Municipal Court; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 8-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service, in furtherance of the City's efforts to advance public health and improve services, to enter into a contract with Toter Incorporated, without the formality of advertising for bids, for the purchase of recycle/trash carts for use by the Public Works Bureau, for a period not to exceed three years; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 9-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids, for the replacement of two pumps at the Eastwood High Booster Station; and declaring it an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 10-2016 authorizing a Conditional Use to construct a multi-family housing development and sale of City-owned land at 366 Beaver Street. ***VOTE: 12-0 (Neal Abstained)***

RES. NO. 11-2016 approving and confirming the appointment of Tracy L. Carter to the Akron Civil Service Commission, for term ending July 31, 2019; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

RES. NO. 12-2016 expressing support for the application of Testa Enterprises, Inc. for the International House at San Tomasso Housing Tax Credit Development to build a development of affordable apartment units in the City; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 13-2016 authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Director of Transportation for the resurfacing of State Route 91 (Canton and Darrow Roads), from the northern corporation limit of the City of Akron to I-76 and from Wedgewood Drive to East Market Street; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

ORD. NO. 14-2016 authorizing the Mayor to file an application and enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio through the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund for funding for capital improvements for the Cascade Valley Park Streambank Restoration Project, in order to protect and enhance the environment and improve the recreational use of the land for Akron citizens; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***

RES. NO. 15-2016 expressing the support of the City of Akron to the community of Flint, Michigan as it works to overcome the challenges of its water quality crisis; urging that those responsible for this situation be held accountable for the devastating effects of their actions and inactions; and expressing heartfelt wishes for justice and recovery in the coming months and years for all those affected, particularly the children and other most vulnerable populations of Flint; and declaring an emergency. ***VOTE: 13-0***
