



# CITY OF AKRON, OHIO

## ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PASSED MARCH 14, 2016:

**ORD. NO. 69-2016** ratifying the actions of the Director of Public Service in entering into a contract with Cioffi Construction Company for the emergency repair of the 12-inch water main on East Tallmadge Avenue near Oxford Avenue; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**ORD. NO. 70-2016** authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract, after publicly advertising for bids through the Office of the Purchasing Agent, for the removal and re-installation of a headworks wastewater screen at the Water Reclamation Facility, in order to maintain continued, reliable operations at the Facility; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**ORD. NO. 71-2016** authorizing a Conditional Use to retain a fence and playhouse at 667 Woodstock Road; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**ORD. NO. 72-2016** authorizing the Director of the Department of Planning and Urban Development to enter into contracts with consultants, for transportation planning in order to carry out the intent and purpose of programs under the Federal Consolidated Planning Grant for the fiscal year 2016, in order to further Mayor Horrigan's objective of creating a more vibrant, livable community through coordinating resources, partners and stakeholders to integrate transportation and land use planning and decisions in the greater Akron area; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**RES. NO. 73-2016** expressing opposition to Ohio House Bill 48, the Guns Everywhere Bill, which would open the door for the concealed carrying of firearms on college campuses and other sensitive and vulnerable locations, including government buildings, school safety zones, daycare centers, private planes, and the public areas of police stations and airport terminals, and would reduce the penalty for licensed gun owners who carry concealed weapons in the few remaining prohibited places; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**RES. NO. 74-2016** urging the Akron Civil Service Commission to adopt adjusted wage scales to increase the hourly wage for the five Public Utilities interns currently earning \$9.65 an hour so that their hourly wage will be \$10.00 an hour; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**RES. NO. 75-2016** expressing support for the decision of Mayor Horrigan and the Director of Finance to make the expenditure information of the City available to the public on the website OhioCheckbook.com, in furtherance of Mayor Horrigan's objectives of enhancing transparency and empowering informed and innovative citizen engagement within the Akron community; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*

**RES. NO. 76-2016** expressing the sincere sympathy and condolences of the City of Akron to the family and loved ones of former First Lady, Nancy Reagan, on the occasion of her passing; expressing appreciation for her many years of advocacy and service to her country and for her part in redefining the role of the First Lady of the United States; and declaring an emergency. *VOTE: 13-0*
